In case of a tie (*hikiwake*) – the winner is chosen using the flag system, <u>without</u> extra time (*ketteisen*).

#### **INDIVIDUAL COMPETITIONS**

- 1. In competitions judged using the flag system, the matches will be conducted in the single-elimination system with repechage.
- 2. Number of athletes from one club in one competition within one rank group: unlimited.
- 3. The minimum number of competitors in one competition in a given grade group: 5 athletes.
- 4. Athlete may not compete in the same competition (e.g., individual kata) in different age and/or rank groups.
- 5. Boys and girls start separately.
- 6. In case of insufficient number of athletes in a group, the athletes will be included in another group, which is closest (most similar) to the age group of these athletes.
- 7. Individual kata will be performed in pairs, the kata will be matched to the level of the lower rank, both in the Elimination rounds and in the finals.
- 8. In group D (3 kyu dan), judges will use the score system.

#### **INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION**

- 1. Kumite single-elimination system with repechage.
- 2. Number of athletes from one club in one competition within one rank group: unlimited.
- 3. The minimum number of competitors in one competition in a given grade group: 5 athletes.
- 4. Athlete may not compete in the same competition (e.g., individual kata) in different age and/or rank groups.
- 5. Boys/Men and Girls/Women start separately.
- 6. In case of insufficient number of athletes in a group, the athletes will be included in another group, which is closest (most similar) to the rank and age group of these athletes.
- 7. Kata scoring system (points).

#### CADETS + JUNIORS TEAM KATA

#### 1. Girls' team kata:

(Elimination rounds: Heian 3-5 or any master kata; final: other kata than performed in the elimination rounds, compulsory with BUNKAI).

#### 2. Boys' team kata:

(Elimination rounds: Heian 3-5 or any master kata; final: other kata than performed in the elimination rounds, compulsory with BUNKAI).

\*Competitor at younger age can NOT be added to the older age group (youth + senior) and she or he can start just in one team

#### YOUTH + SENIOR TEAM KATA

1. **Women's team kata**: (any master kata, in finals other kata than during the elimination rounds, compulsory with BUNKAI).

2. **Men's team kata**: (any master kata, in finals other kata than during the elimination rounds, compulsory with BUNKAI).

\* Competitor at younger age (cadet + junior) can NOT be added to the older age group and she or he can start just in one team

## DESCRIPTION KIHON IPPON KUMITE, JIYU IPPON KUMITE

#### Kihon Ippon Kumite.

#### **NO PROTECTORS!**

#### TORI: (the attacking competitor):

- 1. Oi zuki jodan x1
- 2. Oi zuki chudan x1
- 3. Maegeri chudan x1
- 4. Mawashigeri jodan x1 (6 kyu and above)

\* tori may check the distance to uke before his first attack \* **attacks** must be performed from the **hidari zenkutsu-dachi** stance in the order listed above: 1,2,3 & 4 (6 kyu+).

TORI ANNOUNCES HIS/HER ATTACK AND MAY PERFORM IT ONLY AFTER UKE HAS CONFIRMED THE ATTACK BY SAYING "OSS"

Each time an attack is performed in a wrong order – warning (overview note reduction). Each time a wrong attack is performed - warning (overview note reduction). If contact is found to be intentional or deliberate - disqualification of the competitor ("Han-soku").

#### UKE (the defending competitor): GO-NO-SEN (after tori's attack)

- 1. Age-uke / Gyakuzuki
- 2. Soto lub Uchi-uke / Gyakuzuki
- 3. Gedan-barai / Gyakuzuki
- 4. Uchi-uke / Gyakuzuki (6 kyu+)

\* uke should wait for the attack in yoi-dachi with no block ready beforehand,

\* although **uke** may step out of the attack line using ", hiraki-ashi", he/she must finish the counterattack in the ", zenkutsu-dashi" stance,

\* the only counterattack that may be performed is chudan GYAKU-ZUKI in the hidari or migi zenkutsu-dachi.

Each time a wrong counterattack is performed - warning (overview note reduction). If contact is found to be intentional or deliberate - disqualification of the competitor ("Han-soku").

**Judging**: overall note "overwiev". In case of a tie (*hikiwake*) – the winner is chosen using the flag system, <u>without</u> extra time (*ketteisen*)

Kihon Ippon Kumite – overview note reduction –		
Making any of the following errors leads to overview note reduction.

#### Jiyu Ippon Kumite.

Protectors are compulsory! (see description "PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS FOR ATHLETES")

#### TORI (attacker):

- 1. Kizamizuki jodan x1
- 2. Gyakuzuki chudan x1
- 3. Maegeri chudan x1
- 4. Mawashigeri jodan x1
- 5. Ushirogeri chudan x1

\* time limit for each attack: 10 seconds (if exceeded - loss of the chance to perform the current attack). \* attacks must be performed in the above order 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) from the **hidari** zenkutsu-dachi stance.

\* an attack may be performed after the uke's guard is broken, however the attack technique must be performed as a continuation of the break-up. If the attack is not continued, the breaking technique will be considered as a performed attack.

#### - without announcing,

- without faking,

(any faked attack made with an action of the body or hand or foot will be considered as a performed attack), - no sweeps or interceptions,

- (each try Kei-koku penalty),
- after an attack, transition to kamae tori may not block any counterattacks.
- (each try Kei-koku penalty)

Wrong attack order - Kei-koku penalty each time.

**Wrong attack** (also attacking from any other stance than hidari zenkutsu-dachi) – <u>Kei-koku</u> penalty. **Stepping out of the bout area** – Jogai procedure.

In case of a contact during bout - circumstances and sanctions as to be assessed per Kumite rules.

#### UKE (defender): GO-NO-SEN (after an opponent's attack)

\* counterattack must be preceded by a block or deflection of an attack; defence from **hidari** or **migi** zenkutsudachi stance

\* a counter-attack can be performed when the attacker has crossed the distance (crossed hands), but only after the guard has been broken without moving the body at the moment the guard has been broken

#### Allowed counterattacks:

- any technique (but only single one).
- no sweeps or interceptions,
- (each try Kei-koku penalty),
- without ostentatiously retreating, preventing the attacker from executing his techniques. (each try Kei-koku penalty),

**Stepping out of the bout area** – Jogai procedure. **Counterattack too soon** – penalty point (Saki).

In case of a contact during bout - circumstances and sanctions as to be assessed per Kumite rules.

Judging: wazari technical point (4), ippon technical point (10), Ko-Go Kumite rules apply. In case of a tie (*hikiwake*) – the winner is chosen using the flag system, <u>without</u> extra time (*ketteisen*). The elimination system with repechage will be applied.

<b>Jiyu Ippon Kumite – CHILDRENS</b> – penalty points–		
Each mistake will result in penalty point "Kei-koku" – apart from contact situation.

### Ko-Go Kumite.

**Protectors are compulsory!** (see description "PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS FOR ATHLETES").

**TORI (attacker):** Ko-Go Kumite rules apply. **UKE (defender)**: Ko-Go Kumite rules apply.

\*both tori and uke fight from free stance.

**Judging:** wazari technical point, ippon technical point, Ko-Go Kumite rules apply. The elimination system with repechage will be applied. In case of a tie (*hikiwake*) – the winner is chosen using the flag system, <u>without</u> extra time (*ketteisen*).

#### **STARTING CONDITIONS FOR ATHLETES:**

- **1.** Appropriate age: according to the listed year of birth.
- 2. Valid medical sports examination.
- 3. Valid accident and health insurance.
- 4. Protectors.

- Mouthguard is compulsory for all groups, starting from Jiyu Ippon KUMITE.
- Boys and men: compulsory groin protector from Group D to Seniors. The protector must be worn under the karate-gi. Athletes without these protectors will not be permitted to fight.
- Girls and women: compulsory breast protector from Group D to Seniors. The protector must be worn under the karate-gi. Athletes without these protectors will not be permitted to fight.

#### 5. <u>Safety of the athletes.</u>

Each athlete participating in a KUMITE competition <u>must not</u> wear:

- long fingernails and toenails (they must be cut shortly, otherwise the athlete will not be be permitted to fight
- rings, chains, earrings, glasses, watches, hairpins and bobby pins (or other hard attachments in the hair), orthotics (or other hard supports for limbs or body parts, except those approved by the competition medical commission).
- 6. Participation fee must be paid in advance.

7. The team leader must sign to the World Cup organizer, that their competing athletes have got: accident insurance, valid medical examinations, consent to publicity, GDPR and the Covid statement.
